Teachers of the Future is a group of students who plan for a career in teaching. The club is made up of a large group of students who represent a variety of grades, ages and ethnicities. They provide numerous educational opportunities for the members in addition to community service work and social opportunities. For example, weekly club meetings include guest speakers from organizations that work with children or provide educational programs. They sponsor numerous field trips all over Arizona including the Arizona Science Center Phoenix Art Museum and Deer Valley Rock Art Center, and students have

the opportunity to learn CPR and obtain first aid certification. Teachers of the Future was awarded a \$1,000 grant from the Arizona Education Association to conduct high school outreach and recruitment. The Club annually sponsors a drive and fundraiser to provide school supplies for needy schools in the Valley. In addition, they sponsored a Christmas Angels Collection and generated money to buy Christmas presents for children and donated the extra money to a women's shelter.
